Text printed in a folder

The couple may sit on chairs Wedding bouquet to bridesmaid

All stand All sit

The couple stands before the altar/priest All stand The couple answers

They take one another's right hand and read the text, which the priest holds They use both first name and last name The priest confirms the consent

The rings are on the altar or the Bestman keeps them They use only first name On the altar stand two small burning candles. The couple walks to the altar, takes each little candle, lights the big candle and blows out the small ones.) All sit. P invites the two witnesses to come forward and sign the document (on a pulpit or on the altar)

All answer, e.g. "Lord, hear our prayer" (printed in the folder) The couple is kneeling All pray (printed in the folder?)

The bride gets her bouquet The couple turns round and stands for some moments. Then they walk slowly out (and wait in a chamber)
